

RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 189

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CREATION OF A TRAINING FUND FOR THE LAWTON POLICE DEPARTMENT AND A SEPARATE FUND FOR THE LAWTON FIRE DEPARTMENT TO BE FUNDED BY MONIES RECEIVED IN MUNICIPAL COURT FINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENSURING SUFFICIENT REVENUES ARE AVAILABLE TO MEET THE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS OF LAWTON POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lawton recognizes that Lawton police officers and firefighters are required to meet annual training requirements imposed by state statutory and in some instances federal law, and;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to ensure adequate revenues are available to fund the training requirements of its police officers and firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it would be appropriate to earmark ten dollars (\$10.00) from all fines imposed by the City of Lawton Municipal Court, with five dollars (\$5.00) going to each training fund, to ensure adequate funding is in place for such training purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, that separate training funds for the Lawton Police Department and Lawton Fire Department be created for the purpose of ensuring sufficient revenues are available to meet the training requirements of Lawton police officers and firefighters. Each training fund will receive five dollars (\$5.00) from each fine imposed and collected by the City of Lawton Municipal Court. All revenues from these funds are to be designated and used specifically for training purposes, with said training funds and all revenues therein to carry over from year to year.


