BULKY WASTE

Collection



Monthly bulky waste collection service is provided for all single-family and duplex residential properties with active utility accounts. **The service is only for large, bulky items that will not fit in a poly cart as well as bagged yard waste and tree limbs.** Bulky waste collection occurs on Wednesdays based upon location (see map on back page for bulk collection schedule). Customers may place bulky items at the curb **no earlier** than the Sunday before their scheduled Wednesday collection day. All items must be at the curb no later than 7am on the scheduled Wednesday collection day. **If waste is set at the curb at other times, the customer will receive a charge on their utility bill for a premium collection or abatement.** Please allow up to three days for crews to pick everything up.

Set out bulky items at least 5 feet from obstructions, such as mailboxes, fences, water and gas meters, parked cars and poly carts. Bulky waste must be placed within 10 feet behind the curb, but not in the street. Do not place items under trees or power lines. Bulky waste in the maximum amount of 4 cubic yards will be collected at no additional fee. Bulky waste greater than 4 cubic yards will be collected, but an additional charge will be placed on utility bill. **If non-collectable types of waste are set at the curb, the customer will receive a charge on their utility bill for a premium collection or abatement.**

Customers can also haul solid waste directly to the landfill located at 8902 SW 11th Street.

Non-Collectable as Bulky Waste



- Household solid waste items that fit in a poly cart
- Automotive fluids (antifreeze, transmission fluid, etc.)
- Automotive repair items (tires, rims, frames, auto parts, etc.)
- Automotive batteries
- Bricks
- Concrete
- Construction debris (uncontained sheetrock, dirt rocks, etc.)
- Liquid waste of any kind
- Fuel storage items (fuel cans, propane tanks, etc.)
- Hazardous waste/chemicals
- Oils (automotive, household, or cooking, etc.)
- Paints and solvents
- Medical wastes (soiled linens, home health products, etc.)
- Windows or glass items
- Bagged, loose or scattered household trash (**place small items and household trash in cart**)
- Explosives
- Pool chemicals

Collectable Bulky Waste



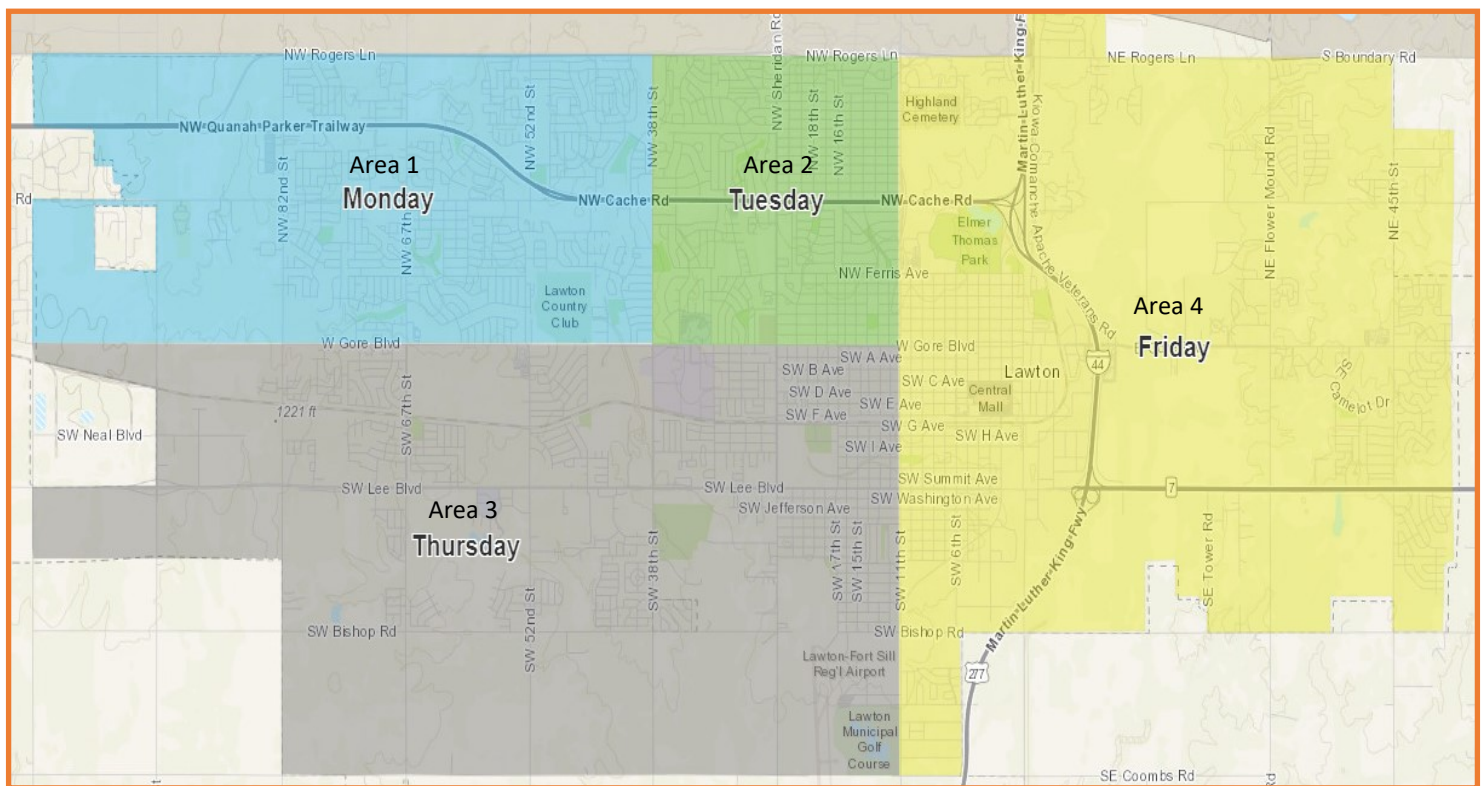
- Large and small household appliances (washers, dryers, water heater, barbecue grills)
- Refrigerators and air conditioners (refrigerant evacuated by licensed HVAC professional)
- Mattresses
- Tree debris (lengths of 6' or less, and max. of 24" in diameter)
- Bagged yard waste (leaves, grass clippings)
- Fencing materials (fence panels 6'x8' or less)
- Lumber (lengths of 6' or less)
- Furniture (couches, chairs, tables)
- Electronics
- Flattened corrugated cardboard (boxes must be broken down)
- Carpet and padding

A door hanger will be left if there is a problem with waste left at the curb.
