A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LAWTON TO APPLY FOR THE OPIOID ABATEMENT BOARD OKLAHOMA OPIOID ABATEMENT REVOLVING FUND GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Under title 74, sections 30.3 through 30.8 create the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants Act. It is the intent of the Legislature, through enactment of the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants Act, to promote and protect the health of Oklahomans by using monetary grants to abate the opioid crisis in a comprehensive manner that includes cooperation and collaboration with political subdivisions, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Lawton submitted the required Letter of Intent to the Opioid Abatement Grant program on September 27, 2023, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Lawton has an existing relationship with the Comanche County Health Department that can be leveraged to provide prevention and education services to the community to meet a significant community need.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, that the City Manager or designee is authorized to submit a grant application on behalf of the City of Lawton to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board Grant Program.
