RESOLUTION NO. 160

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CREATION OF A RECYCLING FUND FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO BE FUNDED BY MONIES RECEIVED FROM THE SALE OF METALS AND OTHER RECYCLE MATERIALS GENERATED FROM THE LANDFILL FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING RECYCLE EQUIPMENT AND RECYCLE OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF LAWTON PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lawton recognizes that the Public Works Department is required to meet permit requirements imposed by state statutory authority (ODEQ) and;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to ensure adequate revenues are available to assist with funding Recycle Equipment and Recycle Operation requirements of its staff; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it would be appropriate to earmark the funds from all sales of recycle products generated from the landfill go into the recycle fund, to ensure adequate funding is in place for purchase of the needed Recycle Equipment and Recycle Operations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, that a separate recycle fund for the Public Works Department be created for the purpose of funding Recycle Equipment and Recycle Operations within the Public Works Department. All revenues generated from the landfill through the sale of metals and other recycle materials be designated and used specifically for the purchase of recycle equipment and recycle operations with said recycle funds and all revenues therein to carryover from year to year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Works Department will administer these funds for the purchase of recycle equipment and recycle operations related to further the recycle program requirements of this department.
