A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF LAWTON SPECIAL REVENUE FUND, REPEALING RESOLUTION 97-126, RESOLUTION 01-136, RESOLUTION 06-189, AND RESOLUTION 10-27, AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THE EXISTING FUND BALANCES.

- **WHEREAS**, the City wishes to combine all current special revenue-type funds into one master Special Revenue Fund for the Tyler implementation; and
- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 97-126 created the Fire Prevention and Education Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 26, which is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler; and
- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 01-136 created the Lawton Project Impact Program Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 45, which is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler; and
- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 06-189 created the Training Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 79, which is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler; and
- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 10-27 created the Municipal Court Department Improvement/LETA Beautification Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 44, which is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma that:
- <u>Section 1.</u> There is hereby established a Special Revenue Fund for the purposes of receiving and disbursing all special revenues.
- Section 2. Resolution 97-126 is hereby repealed and the Fire Prevention and Education Fund Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 26, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton Special Revenue Fund.
- Section 3. Resolution 01-136 is hereby repealed and the Lawton Project Impact Program Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 45, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton Special Revenue Fund.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Resolution 06-189 is hereby repealed and the Training Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 79, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton Special Revenue Fund.
- Section 5. Resolution 10-27 is hereby repealed and the Municipal Court Department Improvement/LETA Beautification Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 44, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton Special Revenue Fund.
 - <u>Section 6.</u> This resolution shall be effective on July 1, 2021.
