## A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 89-88, CLOSING CERTAIN CITY OF LAWTON FUNDS THAT ARE NO LONGER NEEDED, AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THE EXISTING FUND BALANCES.

**WHEREAS,** Resolution 89-88 created the Community Development Block Grant Small Business Revolving Loan Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 22, which is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler; and

**WHEREAS,** the LUHA Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 10, currently exists in GEMS but is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler; and

**WHEREAS,** the HOME Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 09, currently exists in GEMS but is no longer necessary with the implementation of Tyler.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma that:

<u>Section 1.</u> Resolution 89-88 is hereby repealed and the Community Development Block Grant Small Business Revolving Loan Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 22, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton CDBG Fund.

Section 2. The LUHA Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 10, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton CDBG Fund.

Section 3. The HOME Fund, a/k/a City of Lawton Fund 09, is hereby closed and any remaining fund balance shall be transferred to the City of Lawton CDBG Fund.

<u>Section 4.</u> This resolution shall be effective on July 1, 2021.
