## **RESOLUTION 21-**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 20-59 AND ESTABLISHING A REVISED ANNUAL FUNDING ALLOCATION FOR ALL FUTURE HOTEL/MOTEL TAX COLLECTIONS RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF LAWTON.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lawton receives hotel/motel tax revenues for the purpose of supporting certain economic development and tourism activities within the community; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Lawton held a special election on February 9, 2021, in which the citizens voted to increase the amount of hotel/motel tax from 5.5% to 7%; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lawton routinely enters into annual contractual agreements with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chamber of Commerce and other organizations to undertake and manage those programs and activities; and

**WHEREAS,** previous resolutions have established funding allocation priorities, as well as a funding formula for a dedicated economic development reserve fund; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, that Resolution 20-59 be amended and replaced by this resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the expenditure of funds from the Economic Development Fund be authorized only upon the passage of a Joint Resolution by the City Council and the Board of Directors of the Lawton-Fort Sill Chamber of Commerce; provided, however, the City may disperse funds from the Economic Development Fund without the necessity of a Joint Resolution to entities created by the City and/or who have designated the City as their beneficiary or with a beneficial interest.
